

The Facts About Cement Grouts

1. Some Cement Grouts are much more than just sand and cement.
2. You can add too much water to Cement Grout. Measure, don't guess.
3. Cement Grouts will freeze if it's cold enough.
4. They are, in general terms, brittle. (especially if they are poured thin)
5. Exposure to wind during curing usually causes cracking.
6. Unrestrained grout is useless for anything but house-keeping.
7. Cement Grout must be properly cured. If not, it will crack and not achieve expected strengths.
8. Cement grouts are usually less expensive than epoxy and other polymer grouts.
9. Most Cement Grouts can be extended with aggregate to make them less expensive to use.
10. Cement Grouts can be mixed and placed in bulk yielding huge savings in labor.
